Credentialing and Recredentialing Courses

We are happy to announce our CASAC Fast-Track **100-Hour CASAC Training Cohort** for post-graduates with clinical licensures. This opportunity focuses on Section I and Section IV of the OASAS approve standardized curriculum and typically completed in 3-4 months. Students will meet for 6-hours each Sunday.

Our Offerings

All classes take place virtually via Zoom. (Computer, laptop or tablet w/ functioning camera, microphone and speakers are required). Our program focuses on interactive learning. You will have 24/7 access to educational activities and content on Google Classroom.

Eligibility Requirements

You may qualify for our fast-track program, if you have a clinical licensure in at least one of the five specific areas:

- Licensed Master Social Worker/Licensed Clinical Social Worker
- Licensed Mental Health Counselor
- Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist
- Licensed Creative Arts Therapist
- Licensed Psychologist

Scholarship Requirements

For our scholarship program, you must complete 100-clock hours of coursework and a minimum of thirty-five (35) hours under the appropriate level of supervision in an appropriate *OASAS-CERTIFIED, OMH-CERTIFIED, or DOH-authorized settings within one (1) year of completing the 100-hour coursework.

You must complete the NYS OASAS Application, Attestation Form, **Employment Verification Form, and submit two letters of recommendation. Submit all requested documents to training@samaritanvillage.org.

*Please note: Priority must be given to individuals who are working at OASAS-certified, funded, or otherwise authorized programs/services (including but not limited to treatment, prevention, recovery, and harm reduction programs), OMH- and/or DOH-certified Integrated Outpatient Services (IOS-SUD), and DOH Drug User Health and/or Harm Reduction programs at the time of application. You are not required to work at one of the approved locations, but must complete 35-hours in an approved setting.

** Individuals who are working at an OASAS/OMH/DOH program must complete the Employment Verification Form. This form can be used in lieu of one letter of recommendation.
